WHEN YOU GET INSIDE THE SHOW



Inside the venue there will be increased ventilation



We have increased the size of the gangways to allow for social distancing and one way systems will be introduced where needed



All seating around the catwalk, VIP area and hospitality outlets will have increased spacing in line with government guidelines



The venue already maintains good housekeeping and are carrying out regular deep cleans as well as an increased cleaning regime during the show



The venue have amended their catering offering to pre-packaged items only
